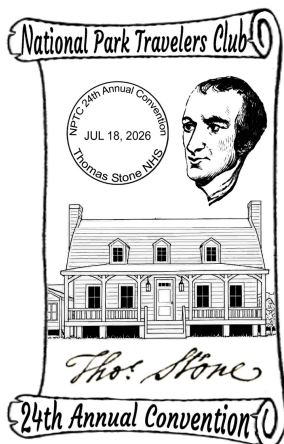

Lee was the last to live there as a child and later married Martha Washington's great granddaughter, Mary Anna Custis). Some guided tours will be provided as well as time on your own. If desired, lunch is available to choose below. We will be having a plated lunch in a private room at *Brock's Riverside Grill* (see options below). The venue has an awesome balcony that overlooks the Rappahannock River and view of a bridge used by Amtrak and the VRE line. If you are there at the right time, you can see the train come through since Fredericksburg station is close by. You are also welcome to bring your own lunch. Bus A will begin the day at George Washington's Ferry Farm and Historic Kenmore with lunch at 12:00 PM. **See description of Bus Tour B for lunch options.** Both buses will visit the same sites and return to the hotel around 6:30 PM.

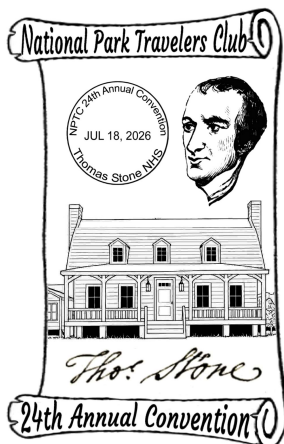

Join fellow NPTC members for an all-day bus tour and group BBQ at Gilbert Run Park. Start your day on a journey that takes you to discover the 'rest of the story' of the Lincoln assassination. Among the stops will be the Surratt House Museum (where Mary Surratt hosted John Wilkes Booth and fellow conspirators to plot the assassination), the Dr. Samuel A. Mudd House Museum (home of the doctor who set Booth's broken leg and helped hide him during the manhunt), and Rich Hill Farm House (childhood home of Thomas Stone's wife, Margaret Brown, and her brother, Dr. Gustavus Brown, who tended to George Washington on his deathbed, as well as being another site where Booth was given food and shelter during the manhunt). Rich Hill Farm House has never been open to the public until now and just completed a 10-year restoration project. Docents will be at each site to provide tours and answer questions. Bus will return to the hotel by 7:30 PM.

Following that tour, the buses will arrive at Gilbert Run Park where you will have some time to enjoy the park prior to dinner. Rent a paddleboat or kayak to go out on the man-made lake (extra fee applies, pay on-your-own), walk the trails and go birdwatching, or visit with the geese. A boxed lunch is available, and dinner is included with this tour. You are also welcome to bring your own lunch. Boxed lunch will be a choice of sandwich: **(1)** turkey & swiss - oven-roasted turkey breast with swiss cheese, lettuce, and signature sauce on honey wheat bread; **(2)** albacore tuna - the best fancy white albacore tuna with swiss cheese and crisp lettuce on sourdough bread; **(3)** roast beef & provolone **(\$1 additional charge)** - lean roast beef and provolone cheese with dijon horseradish sauce on 13-grain bread; **(4)** avocado smash - a blend of garbanzo beans, avocado, garlic, and spices on a bed of green leaf lettuce with tomatoes, roasted red peppers, cucumbers, and sprouts on sourdough bread; or **(5)** vegetarian - mushrooms, cucumbers, vine-ripened tomatoes, sprouts, roasted red peppers, and avocados on lettuce with cheddar cheese and pesto mayonnaise on 13-grain bread. *All sandwiches come with chips, fresh fruit, dill pickle, cookie, mint, soda, and bottled water.*

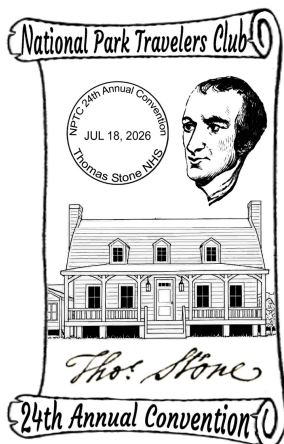

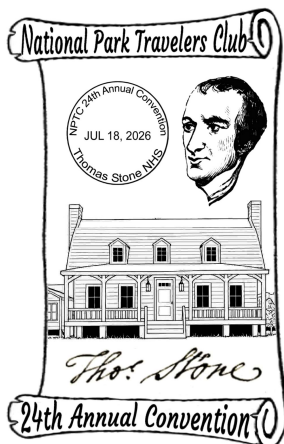

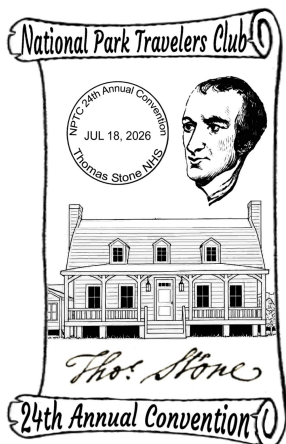
